#### **Meeting Minutes**

#### Minutes:

- 1:30 pm Chairman Perusse begins the meeting and welcomes new members to the Committee

- 1:45 pm Executive Order Discussion
  - Committee members express interest in creating a mission and vision. Members mentioned these should outline the scope of the committee.
  - OSBM suggested two working groups: One focused on applying analytical tools in state government and the other on accessing and using data and evidence. Committee members are in favor of working groups. The mission and vision could help inform the work of the working groups.
  - Committee members are interested in the committee continuing to serve as a venue for sharing best practices and highlighting work already being done within agencies related to performance management.
  - Committee members also suggested that the committee should be anticipatory, make sure performance management is inclusive, to remember that there is no one size fits all and to be thoughtful about what is needed and why.

  - o OSBM presented on the Governor's FY21-23 budget recommendations related to making government more effective, efficient, and responsive.
  - Committee members mentioned that the internal audit issue was complex due to problems with the current classification and compensation of the positions, as well as recruitment and retention and lack of continuing education opportunities.
